

REGIONAL LEADERS TERMS OF REFERENCE 2024-2025

DESCRIPTION

The Regional Leaders are young members of the Global Youth Coalition for Road Safety who show outstanding leadership skills and commitment to making youth voices heard in road safety.

The regional leaders play a crucial role in bringing the benefits of the Global Youth Coalition to local and regional groups of changemakers through localised activities and opportunities.

MANDATE

The Regional Leaders period lasts for 12 months and aims to meaningfully engage young leaders in mobilising and engaging Youth Coalition members from their respective regions to positively impact road safety in their local communities.

The Global Youth Coalition for Road Safety seeks applications from motivated and active young leaders with interest and experience in mobilising youth to act for road safety and sustainable mobility. Each region will have 2 to 3 regional leaders, depending on the size of our membership in that area and other needs identified. Therefore, this is a role that demands constant coordination with your co-leader.

Location	Global/Remote We aim to have regional representation in each world region (Asia, Africa, Europe, Latin America, North America, and Oceania).
Honoraries	Regional Leaders will receive an honorarium compensation upon the successful completion of the activities to recognise the time commitments and expertise they are inputting to the Youth Coalition.

End date	April 2025
Hours per week	We estimate that you will spend between 8-10 hours a month planning and implementing your activities and attending coordination meetings with your co-leaders.

ABOUT THE ROLE



RESPONSIBILITIES

The Regional Leader commit to the following activities for a 12-month period:

- 1. **Organise events and activities** that support engagement and recruitment of members on a regional level and the relation between road safety and the SDGs, ensuring that those activities are in line with the annual planning of the Global Youth Coalition;
- 2. Promote the Global Youth Coalition for Road Safety and the YOURS Academy to other young people from your region by raising their awareness on joining as a member, accessing resources, and attending events;
- 3. **Reach out to regional and local youth networks** to expand the number of members in your region;
- 4. **Identify opportunities** that can be relevant to other talented members and share them with the Global Youth Coalition secretariat;
- 5. Disseminate the latest updates on activities, events, and opportunities via WhatsApp, social media, email, and other platforms to ensure the presence of members from your regions;
- 6. Schedule and attend monthly virtual meetings with your co-leaders to plan and follow up on your region's tasks;
- 7. Attend quarterly virtual meetings with regional leaders of other regions and other leadership structures to present and evaluate your progress and exchange perspectives on youth engagement at the Coalition.

DURATION AND COORDINATION PROCESS

Regional Leaders will develop their duties remotely (online) for a period of **12 months from April 2024 until April 2025.** They must communicate regularly with their co-leaders and other members through email or other online collaboration tools and platforms.

The activities planning will be presented and approved before the beginning of each quarter, so regional leaders can implement it for three months. Before the end of the quarter, Leaders will have a quarterly evaluation and plan for the next quarter.

CRITERIA

Age Range: 18-32 years old.

Knowledge: Familiar with the Sustainable Development Goals and the global road safety crisis facing youth.

Experience & skills:

- 1. Active member of the Coalition: joined the Global Youth Coalition for Road Safety as a member and is actively participating in our activities and events, is familiar with our network, and connected with other members.
- 2. **Outstanding leadership**: having the ability to lead and inspire others. Self-motivated and have soft skills that support their role (speaks multiple languages, graphic design, translation, planning, etc).



- 3. **Committed**: having the ability to dedicate a certain amount (8-10 hours) of time every month to get in touch with their peers and be actively engaged with other members.
- 4. **Teamplayer**: interested in working collaboratively and agreeing on a coordination system with your co-regional leaders to lead effective engagement and recruitment strategies. Also having the ability to communicate effectively with people from different backgrounds and experiences, open-minded and comfortable with working online.
- 5. Act beyond countries: Regional Leaders are representatives of their regions; they represent the voices of young people in multiple countries, and should be in touch with other members beyond their countries and think on regional and global scales.
- 6. **Proactive**: willing to take the initiative to reach out and initiate communication with other youth structures in the Coalition and other youth organisations. Ready to explore new approaches to achieve more engagement and recruitment.

Soft Skills:

- Personable, approachable and easy to get along with.
- Works well with different groups of people.
- Excellent written and oral command of English and their local language.

Principles and policies: The candidate must adopt the organisation's <u>policies</u> and the Youth Coalition <u>Code of Conduct</u>.

BENEFITS

- 1. Receive **capacity-building training** to strengthen your professional and leadership skills (in-person and online).
- 2. **Represent the Global Youth Coalition** at regional and global events to raise youth voices on road safety and sustainable mobility.
- 3. Exclusive **access to the Youth Talent Pool**, a space for talented young road safety leaders (like you!) at the Global Youth Coalition that connects you with exclusive training, education and funding opportunities.
- 4. Regional Leaders receive an **annual honorarium compensation** upon the successful completion of the activities committed per quarter.
- 5. Those with internet issues could receive specific support for events and activities that demand a stable **internet connection**.

SELECTION PROCESS

Individuals who are interested in applying to be on the Regional Leaders of the Global Youth Coalition for Road Safety need to meet the criteria listed above and register through the online process.
